

Passing Your Property Review

Accessibility:
Make sure all areas of the home, yard & additional structures are accessible. If this is not the case, it may result in a failed property review causing a second review to be scheduled, with an additional fee.
Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Alarms:
Make sure all provided smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are in their proper locations and in working order. As stated in your lease, there will be a \$200 fine if alarms are found to be disconnected, missing or not in working condition.
Cleaning:
Be sure to clean your home and make a good impression. If your home is too dirty or causing necessary repairs to the unit, we may hire a maid on your behalf which you will be charged for, or it may prevent your lease from being renewed altogether. Remember inside & outside of all appliances, walls & flooring, kitchen & bathroom sinks, bathtubs, etc. No garbage or storage, and home is uncluttered.
Landscaping:
If you are responsible for landscaping, make sure all landscaping is maintained and looks presentable so you will not have to pay for a landscaper to come out.
Repairs:
Make a list of any needed repairs or general maintenance and leave on the kitchen counter for the Owner/Agent. It's better if you let them know, even if you are responsible for the repair, then for them to find it on their own without your disclosure.
